Order of Worship for Sundays in Easter

As We Gather:

April 26: Each Sunday our hearts burn within us as the scriptures are proclaimed and Christ appears to us as bread is broken.

May 3: Today is sometimes called "Good Shepherd Sunday." Jesus is called the "gate" of the sheep in today's gospel.

May 10: Today's gospel includes Jesus' promise that he goes to prepare a place for his followers in his Father's house.

May 17: Jesus does not leave his followers orphaned. Through the Holy Spirit Jesus comes to abide with his disciples of every generation.

May 24: Today we gather with the disciples in the upper room, waiting for the Spirit to transform the church around the world.

Preservice Music Welcome & Announcements Gathering Hymn:

Thanksgiving for Baptism

L: Alleluia! Christ is risen.

ALL: Christ is risen indeed. Alleluia!

L: Joined to Christ in the waters of baptism, we are raised with him to new life. Let us give thanks for the gift of baptism.

(Water may be poured into a bowl at this time.)

L: We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning you created us in your image and planted us in a well-watered garden. 

A brief update regarding activities of WELCA, synodically and churchwide. At this time the Spring convention that was to be held at Trinity in Cashton is cancelled until 2021, as recommended by Churchwide. (The 2021 La Crosse Area WELCA will be hosted by Our Savior's in La Crosse on April 17th.) Possibly the Fall Renewal that is on the calendar for October 17th at First Lutheran in Onalaska will also be cancelled. Trying to be positive at this time but certainly I will relay the final decision later this summer.

Speaking of summer – the churchwide board is meeting via zoom on April 25th. They will be making a decision regarding the triennial convention and the "Just Love" gathering. I would expect that it would be rescheduled if unsafe to have it in July. These are "crazy" times with many unknowns. For those of you that have registered, hold off on flight and hotel reservations. I will forward the results of that meeting as soon as I know through the synod update and Mona's Crosswinds mailing list.

PLEASE send in your convention offerings even though we are unable to meet. Our budget and churchwide's budget depend on your continued generous offerings.
